BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

*SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-9-112 is amended to read as follows:
12-9-112. County sheriff as law enforcement officer.*

*~~Any~~ A former county sheriff of a county who has served as county sheriff
within that county for at least ~~ten (10)~~ eight (8) years and who meets all
minimum hiring standards prescribed by the Arkansas Commission on Law
Enforcement Standards and Training shall be deemed is qualified to be
employed as a law enforcement officer ~~for any municipality located within~~
~~that county, notwithstanding any law or regulation to the contrary~~ with a
municipality, county, or state board.*
