BE LEVIED BY THE ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY
COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE FEES THAT
CAN BE LEVIED BY THE ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK
AND POULTRY COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 2-40-206(a)(1), concerning the funding of the brucellosis program, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) In order to fund or partially fund the brucellosis control and eradication program, there is hereby levied ~~until July 1, 1990,~~ a fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per head on all cattle sold in this state; ~~after which the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission shall establish the amount of the fee it feels necessary to continue to be used for the brucellosis program.~~
