## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 1 OF  
THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING GENERAL PROVISIONS OF  
ARKANSAS LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 1  
OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING GENERAL  
PROVISIONS OF ARKANSAS LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 1-2-304(b), concerning the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, is amended to read as follows to reflect that, pursuant to Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 29, an appropriation by the General Assembly is limited to one (1) fiscal year:

(b) In no event shall the commission create a financial commitment or obligation, to be paid by the commission or the State of Arkansas, in excess of the funds available to the commission for the ~~biennial period~~ fiscal year in which the services or obligations are incurred.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. The enactment and adoption of this act shall not repeal, expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular session of the Ninetieth General Assembly. All such acts shall have the full force and effect, and so far as those acts intentionally vary from or conflict with any provision contained in this act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or repealing the appropriate parts



of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
