AN ACT TO ALLOW SCHOOL VACATIONS TO LAST SEVEN (7)
WEEKS IN SCHOOLS THAT OPERATE ON A TWELVE-MONTH
CALENDAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO ALLOW SCHOOL VACATIONS TO LAST SEVEN
(7) WEEKS IN SCHOOLS THAT OPERATE ON A
TWELVE-MONTH CALENDAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-10-108(b), concerning a twelve-month school year, is amended to read as follows:

(b) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires, “twelve-month year-round educational program” means an educational program in which all students attend school no fewer than the number of days required by the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and School Districts between July 1 and June 30 of each school year and in which no vacation, including summer, lasts more than ~~six (6)~~ seven (7) weeks.
