SENATE BILL 311

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PERMIT A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OR A DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO HAVE HIS OR HER POST OFFICE BOX LISTED AS HIS OR HER ADDRESS ON HIS OR HER DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PERMIT A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OR A DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO HAVE HIS OR HER POST OFFICE BOX LISTED AS HIS OR HER ADDRESS ON HIS OR HER DRIVER'S LICENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-801(a)(2), concerning information required to be on a person's driver's license, is amended to read as follows:

(2) Each license shall include:

(A) A distinguishing number assigned to the licensee;

(B)(i) Except as provided under subdivision (a)(2)(B)(ii)

of this section, the name, residence address, date of birth, and a brief description of the licensee.

(ii) The following exceptions to providing a residence address and instead providing a post office box address shall be allowed at the option of the licensee:

(a) If the licensee is a law enforcement officer; or

(b) If the licensee is a victim of domestic



violence or the dependent of a victim of domestic violence as provided under § 27-16-811; ~~and~~.

(iii) If the licensee is an elected prosecuting attorney or a duly appointed deputy prosecuting attorney, he or she may use a post office box address or his or her office address instead of his or her residence address; and

(C) A space upon which the licensee may affix his or her signature.
