SENATE BILL 395

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE VERIFICATION THAT A FIREARM
BEING SOLD THAT HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY OWNED IS NOT
STOLEN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE VERIFICATION THAT A
FIREARM BEING SOLD THAT HAS BEEN
PREVIOUSLY OWNED IS NOT STOLEN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 73, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

5-73-112. Sale of previously owned firearms.

(a) A licensed firearms dealer may not knowingly sell a previously owned firearm without verification from the Arkansas Crime Information Center that the firearm has not been reported stolen to a law enforcement agency.

(b) A violation of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
