AN ACT CONCERNING THE CRIMINAL OFFENSES INVOLVING
MISDEMEANOR THEFT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE CRIMINAL OFFENSES
INVOLVING MISDEMEANOR THEFT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-36-103(b)(3)(A), concerning the amount of money that constitutes theft of property that is a Class D felony, is amended to read as follows:

(A) The value of the property is five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less but more than ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500);

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-36-103(b)(4)(A), concerning the amount of money that constitutes misdemeanor theft of property, is amended to read as follows:

(A) The value of the property is ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500) or less; or

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-36-104(c)(3), concerning the amount of money that constitutes theft of services that is a Class D felony, is amended to read as follows:

(3) Class D felony if the value of the service is five thousand



dollars (\$5,000) or less but more than ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500); or

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 5-36-105(b), concerning the amount of money that constitutes theft of property that is lost, mislaid, or delivered by mistaken that is a Class D felony, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Theft of property lost, mislaid, or delivered by mistake is a:

(1) Class D felony if the value of the property is ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500) or more; or

(2) Class B misdemeanor if:

(A) The value of the property is less than ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ but more than five hundred dollars (\$500); or

(B) The property is a:

(i) Credit card or credit card account number; or

(ii) Debit card or debit card account number; ~~or,~~

~~(3) Class C misdemeanor if otherwise committed.~~

SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 5-36-106(e)(3)(A), concerning the amount of money that constitutes theft by receiving that is a Class D felony, is amended to read as follows:

(A) The value of the property is five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less but more than ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500);
