SENATE BILL 870

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SCHOOL DISTRICT FUNDS
FOR MEMBERSHIP IN ORGANIZATIONS UNDER CERTAIN
CIRCUMSTANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SCHOOL DISTRICT
FUNDS FOR MEMBERSHIP IN ORGANIZATIONS
UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 20, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-20-108. Dues paid to membership extracurricular activity organizations.

(a) A school district shall not join an extracurricular activity organization domiciled in the state of Arkansas or use school district funds to pay membership dues to an organization unless the organization is represented by a board of directors or other governing body that is appointed by the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

(b) The governing body of an extracurricular activity organization that is domiciled in the state of Arkansas and uses school district funds to pay membership dues shall be comprised of:

(1) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor;

(2) Two (2) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and



(3) Two (2) members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
