For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE ARKANSAS FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OF 1967; TO PROTECT THE PRIVACY OF RETIRED AND FORMER STATE EMPLOYEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE ARKANSAS FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OF 1967; AND TO PROTECT THE PRIVACY OF RETIRED AND FORMER STATE EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(b), concerning exemptions from the disclosure requirement, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(20) Unless the retired or former government employee has permitted release of the information in writing, the personal information of a government employee who retired or otherwise ended his or her employment with the government no less than sixty (60) days before the request for disclosure under this section except the following:

(A) The employee's name;

(B) The agency or department of employment;



(C) The employee's rank or position when his or her service was terminated;

(D) The dates of the employee's service;

(E) Awards, decorations, and other commendations for the employee; and

(F) The name of the city or town of the last known address of the employee and the date the address was last known.
