SENATE BILL 899

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMMISSIONER OF STATE LANDS' ADMINISTRATION OF LAWS CONCERNING ISLANDS AND SUBMERGED LANDS; TO GRANT THE COMMISSIONER OF STATE LANDS IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR GOOD FAITH ACTIONS TO ADMINISTER LAWS CONCERNING ISLANDS AND SUBMERGED LANDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO GRANT THE COMMISSIONER OF STATE LANDS IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR GOOD FAITH ACTIONS TO ADMINISTER LAWS CONCERNING SUBMERGED LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 22-6-202, concerning the title to and administration of islands and submerged lands, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(f) The Commissioner of State Lands is immune from liability for any claim for damages, costs, fees, or other relief or remedy based upon any action or inaction he or she takes in good faith to administer this subchapter.
