## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A CITIZENS' REVIEW BOARD ON  
POLICING PRACTICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO ESTABLISH A CITIZENS' REVIEW BOARD ON  
POLICING PRACTICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to establish a Citizens' Review Board on Policing Practices. The board's purpose shall be to promote the building, advancing, and maintaining of positive relationships between law enforcement and communities they serve and to empower an independent citizens group to assure the public that complaints or other appropriate matters are investigated thoroughly, transparently, completely, and fairly. Further, the board shall recommend, advocate for, and promote fair and transparent policing practices.
