SENATE BILL 950

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
HEALTH TO ISSUE OR ADOPT RULES CONCERNING
TRANSPORTATION OF MEDICAL WASTE THAT ARE MORE
STRINGENT OR LIMITING THAN FEDERAL LAW; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT
OF HEALTH TO ISSUE OR ADOPT RULES
CONCERNING TRANSPORTATION OF MEDICAL
WASTE THAT ARE MORE STRINGENT OR LIMITING
THAN FEDERAL LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-32-106, concerning rules and regulations of disposal of commercial medical waste, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(d) The department shall not issue or adopt rules concerning the transportation of medical waste that are more stringent or limiting than 49 C.F.R. §§ 100 - 185, as it existed on January 1, 2015.
