For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED VEHICLES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED VEHICLES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-906(a)(084), concerning the maximum number of authorized vehicles for the Department of Information Systems, is amended to read as follows:

(084) Department of Information ~~Services~~ Systems 7 14

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that a recent audit recommended that the Department of Information Systems consider purchasing additional state vehicles as needed for employees that travel extensively; that the purchase of additional vehicles as recommended will reduce mileage and rental vehicle costs for the department; and that this act should become effective immediately to generate a more efficient and cost-effective use of state resources. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being



immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
