AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, to be payable from the Nonmunicipal Domestic Sewage Treatment Works Trust Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, professional fees, maintenance, and completed closure of a nonmunicipal domestic sewage treatment works of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the sum of

SECTION 35. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP - HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT PROGRAM. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality - Hazardous Waste Permit Program for the ~~2015-2016~~ 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Four (4) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. These four positions are utilized for a specific project and are specifically exempt from the limitations, either by act or regulation, of hours worked.

SECTION 36. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EQUIPMENT PURCHASE RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Hazardous Substance Remedial Action Trust Fund for the purchase of departmental laboratory

equipment, including maintenance contracts, and data processing equipment and mission-critical software, including maintenance contracts, as appropriated in Section 13, in Items (03)(D) and (05) shall be funded only through interest earnings from the Hazardous Substance Remedial Action Trust Fund. Further, the Department shall report biennially to the Legislative Council all expenditures from interest earnings for these purchases.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 37. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. APPROPRIATIONS RESTRICTIONS. No expenditure from the Environmental Settlement Trust Fund for information technology needs may be made without prior approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, after seeking review of the Arkansas Legislative Council. Further, utilization of this appropriation for information technology needs of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality must also be approved by the Executive Chief Information Officer after the project is evaluated on the methodology recommended by the Chief Information Officer and the CIO Council, including an analysis of the return on investment and linkage to the Department's business objectives. Any approved projects and expenditures for information technology from the Environmental Settlement Trust Fund shall be reported annually to the Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and Information Technology.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 38. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADEQ ASBESTOS PROGRAM. The fees collected pursuant to Arkansas Code 20-27-1004(5) shall be used by the department to fund operational expenses and to provide and train personnel to administer an asbestos program, as funding is available, including:

- (a) Personnel dedicated to issue certificates and licenses to qualified persons/companies, to perform audit of trainers, and to regularly update the ADEQ web page providing a listing of asbestos licensed parties;
- (b) Personnel who are trained as asbestos supervisors as defined by Arkansas

Code 20-27-1003 and Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission Regulation No.21 to approve asbestos Notices of Intent, perform and coordinate asbestos inspections, conduct enforcement actions, and provide regulatory compliance information to assist the regulated community. Asbestos inspectors shall have personal protective equipment when needed to enter a regulated area; and

(c) Other personnel as necessary to administer the asbestos program.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Department shall present the following data to Legislative Council quarterly, due by the 15th day of the month following the quarter:

- a) Number and type of environmental permits currently authorized by the Department and the Pollution Control and Ecology Commission in each environmental permit category;
- b) Total funds collected from permit fees for each permit category and the percent increase or decrease in permit fees annually;
- c) Description of each environmental permit application pending in each environmental permit category, the number of days each permit has been pending, and the reasons for delays in issuing permits for each permit that has been pending for more than 45 days;
- d) Number and type of enforcement actions initiated by the Department, the geographic location of each violation and the total fines and collections from Supplemental Environmental Projects, the percent increase or decrease in fines levied annually and
- e) Description of all pending rulemaking activities and justifications thereof, including economic impact and environmental benefit analysis.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may transfer from various

department funds to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fund Account, the sum of \$1,500,000 in fiscal year ~~2015-2016~~ 2016-2017, for the exclusive purpose of supplementing funding for the appropriation provided in Section 3. Appropriation - State Operations. The funds shall be used for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality - State Operations. Funds which remain in the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fund Account at the close of the fiscal year shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the following fiscal year. These funds shall be used for the purpose stated above.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015-2016~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. For the purposes of the fund transfers provided for in Section 40 - Fund Transfer Provision, the amounts transferred shall not be considered as part of any statutory limitation on the use of funds for administration of programs of the Department.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015-2016~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LANDFILL POST-CLOSURE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Any expenditures in excess of \$50,000 per site from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund, as appropriated in Section 20, Item (04) for corrective action to remedy environmental impacts of closed disposal sites previously operated as a landfill pursuant to state law will be prioritized and authorized by the Commission after addressing corrective actions needed to address environmental impacts from permitted landfills closed properly. Expenditures exceeding \$2,000,000 per fiscal year must be approved by the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015-2016~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. NON HAZARDOUS SITE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund for the cleanup of non hazardous sites which pose a threat to the environment, as appropriated in Section 32, shall be funded only through interest earnings from the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund. The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality shall seek cost recovery from parties responsible for damages to the environment that dictate the use of appropriation authorized in Section 32 of this act, as well as, any other funds spent by a governmental entity to remediate such non hazardous sites.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~ 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LANDFILL POST-CLOSURE TRUST FUND.

(a) The General Assembly finds that:

(1) A growing number of regional solid waste management districts within the state are facing difficulty in funding the necessary costs of closure and post-closure care of landfills owned by the districts; and

(2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills, irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur.

(b) *Notwithstanding Arkansas Code § 8-6-1001 et seq. and Acts 2014, No. 1202, § 41, any Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund cleanup restrictions enumerated in this Act,* the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality also may:

(1) Expend monies from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund to a state-approved contractor or the regional solid waste management district to complete all actions necessary to achieve the final closure and post-closure care of a landfill owned by a regional solid waste management district if the department determines that the regional solid waste management district:

(A) Has filed for protection under federal bankruptcy law;

(B) Is unable to meet its debt obligations in the ordinary course of its operations; or

(C) Is otherwise insolvent; and

(2) Institute a civil action against the regional solid waste

management district and all of the entities composing the regional solid waste management district to seek the recovery of any funds expended from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund under subdivision (b)(1) of this section, unless satisfactory repayment arrangements are reached and agreed upon by the department with the district and the bondholders.

(c) This section is in effect only from July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2017.

SECTION 45. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUSPENSION OF LANDFILL DISPOSAL FEES TO SUPPORT A COMPUTER AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT RECYCLING PROGRAM.

(a) The landfill disposal fee to support a computer and electronic equipment recycling program levied under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(a) shall not be levied from the effective date of this act through June 30, 2017.

(b) Any landfill disposal fees collected under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(a) before the effective date of this act shall be:

(1) Collected as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(c); and

(2) Distributed as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-616 and this Act.

The provision of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

SECTION 46. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 47. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 48. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
