AN ACT TO GRANT MUNICIPAL CLERKS THE AUTHORITY TO
ADMINISTER OATHS OF OFFICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO GRANT MUNICIPAL CLERKS THE AUTHORITY
TO ADMINISTER OATHS OF OFFICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-42-106(b)(1), concerning oaths for
municipal officers, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2) of this section, the
officers shall take their oaths before:

(A) the The Secretary of State or his or her official
designee;

(B) any A justice or judge;

(C) A judge of the county court;

(D) A clerk of the:

(i) county County court;

(ii) clerk of the circuit Circuit court; or

(iii) City of the first class;

(E) A recorder of:

(i) A city of the second class; or

(ii) An incorporated town; or

(F) A justice of the peace.
