## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW A STUDENT TO CHOOSE WHICH GRADE IN WHICH TO TAKE THE COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS ASSESSMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO ALLOW A STUDENT TO CHOOSE WHICH GRADE IN WHICH TO TAKE THE COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS ASSESSMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-441(b)(1)(B), concerning college and career readiness assessments, is amended to read as follows:

(B)(i) A public school that serves students in grades ten through twelve (10-12) shall administer a college and career readiness assessment approved by the state board to each student before the student graduates from high school.

(ii) The public school shall allow the student to choose whether to take the college and career readiness assessment under subdivision (b)(1)(B)(i) of this section in grade ten (10) or grade eleven (11).
