AN ACT CONCERNING THE MILITARY JUSTICE PUNISHMENT FOR
CONTEMPT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE MILITARY JUSTICE
PUNISHMENT FOR CONTEMPT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-64-520 is amended to read as follows:
12-64-520. Contempt.

(a) A military court may punish for contempt ~~any~~ a person who uses ~~any~~ a menacing word, sign, or gesture in its presence, or who disturbs its proceedings by ~~any~~ riot or disorder.

(b) The punishment may not exceed confinement for thirty (30) days or a fine of ~~one hundred dollars (\$100)~~ five hundred dollars (\$500), or both.
