BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-64-508 is amended to read as follows:
12-64-508. Procedural rules.

The ~~procedure~~ procedures used by general, special, and summary courts-
martial shall be the same as those ~~used by~~ established by the United States
Congress for similar courts of the United States Army and United States Air
Force, however, the Governor has executive authority over the military courts
of the organized militia.
