## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE MINIMUM TEACHER COMPENSATION  
SCHEDULE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE MINIMUM TEACHER COMPENSATION  
SCHEDULE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-2403(b), concerning the minimum teacher compensation schedule, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Each school district in the state shall have in place a salary schedule with at least the following minimum levels of compensation for a basic contract:
