AN ACT TO REQUIRE LIFETIME REGISTRATION ON THE
ARKANSAS SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY FOR A PERSON CONVICTED
OF RAPE WHEN THE RAPE INVOLVED THE USE OF FORCE; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE LIFETIME REGISTRATION ON THE
ARKANSAS SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY FOR A
PERSON CONVICTED OF RAPE WHEN THE RAPE
INVOLVED THE USE OF FORCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-919(a), concerning lifetime registration required for certain sex offenders, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) Lifetime registration is required for a sex offender who:
- (1) Was found to have committed an aggravated sex offense;
 - (2) Was determined by the court to be or assessed as a Level 4 sexually dangerous person; ~~or~~
 - (3) Has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been found guilty of a second or subsequent sex offense under a separate case number, not multiple counts on the same charge; or
 - (4) Was convicted of rape by forcible compulsion, § 5-14-103(a)(1), or other substantially similar offense in another jurisdiction.
