BEVERAGE SALES ON CHRISTMAS DAY; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO REPEAL THE LAW PROHIBITING ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGE SALES ON CHRISTMAS DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-211 is repealed.

~~3-3-211. Sales on Christmas Day.~~

~~(a) It shall be unlawful to sell intoxicating liquors on Christmas Day.~~

~~(b) Any person who shall sell intoxicating alcoholic liquors on Christmas Day shall be guilty of a Class B misdemeanor.~~
