AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 13 OF
THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING MUSEUMS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 13
OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING MUSEUMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 13-5-1004(a), concerning the procedure for obtaining ownership of an abandoned loan, is amended to read as follows:

(a) By complying with subsection (b) or subsection (c) of this section, a museum may obtain ownership of a loan if:

(1) The loan agreement has expired; or

(2) Both:

(A) The loan has been in the museum's custody for more than ten (10) years; and

(B) The loan agreement does not provide for a longer term for the loan or another disposition.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. CONSTRUCTION AND LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

It is the intent of the General Assembly that:

(1) The enactment and adoption of this act shall not expressly or impliedly repeal an act passed during the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly;



(2) To the extent that a conflict exists between an act of the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly and this act:

(A) The act of the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly shall be treated as a subsequent act passed by the General Assembly for the purpose of:

(i) Giving the act of the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly its full force and effect; and

(ii) Amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987; and

(B) Section 1-2-107 shall not apply; and

(3) This act shall make only technical, not substantive, changes to the Arkansas Code of 1987.
