AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING MANDATORY SEAT
BELT USE; TO MAKE A VIOLATION OF THE MANDATORY SEAT
BELT USE LAW A SECONDARY OFFENSE FOR ENFORCEMENT
PURPOSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING MANDATORY
SEAT BELT USE; TO MAKE A VIOLATION OF THE
MANDATORY SEAT BELT USE LAW A SECONDARY
OFFENSE FOR ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 37, Subchapter 7, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

27-37-704. Inspection for compliance.

A law enforcement officer shall not stop the operator of a motor vehicle solely to determine compliance with this subchapter.
