HOUSE BILL 1410

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS REGULATORY REFORM ACT OF 2013; TO PROHIBIT A TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROVIDER FROM RESTRICTING RESIDENTIAL INTERNET DATA USAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS REGULATORY REFORM ACT OF 2013; AND TO PROHIBIT A TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROVIDER FROM RESTRICTING RESIDENTIAL INTERNET DATA USAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 17, Subchapter 4, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

23-17-419. Internet data usage – Limitations prohibited.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a telecommunications provider shall not restrict or limit the amount of data usage by a residential internet data plan.

(b) This section does not apply to a mobile or cellular plan that provides data and cellular services.
