AN ACT TO PROVIDE LOCAL CONTROL OVER FLUORIDE LEVELS
IN WATER SYSTEMS THAT SERVE FIVE THOUSAND (5,000)
USERS OR FEWER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO PROVIDE LOCAL CONTROL OVER FLUORIDE
LEVELS IN WATER SYSTEMS THAT SERVE FIVE
THOUSAND (5,000) USERS OR FEWER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-7-136(b), concerning a statewide fluoridation program, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) The company, corporation, municipality, county, government agency, or other entity that owns or controls a water system that serves five thousand (5,000) users or fewer shall control determine whether the company, corporation, municipality, county, government agency, or other entity will adjust the quantity of fluoride in the water.

(2) so as to maintain a If the company, corporation, municipality, county, government agency, or other entity determines to adjust the quantity of fluoride in the water, the adjusted quantity of fluoride in the water shall not exceed the maximum fluoride content established by the Department of Health.
