AN ACT TO PROHIBIT *CERTAIN PERSONS* FROM SERVING AS
MAYOR OF A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS FOR MORE THAN
TWENTY-FOUR (24) YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT *CERTAIN PERSONS* FROM SERVING
AS MAYOR OF A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS FOR
MORE THAN A QUARTER OF A CENTURY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-43-401(a)(1), concerning a mayor of a city of the first class, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1)(A) The mayor shall hold his or her office during the term for which he or she ~~shall have~~ has been elected and until his or her successor ~~shall have~~ has been elected and qualified.

(B)(i) A person shall not serve as mayor for more than twenty-four (24) years, whether consecutive or nonconsecutive.

(ii) Subdivision (a)(1)(B)(i) of this section does not apply to a person serving as mayor on the effective date of this act.
