AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
ARKANSAS STATE POLICE CONCERNING THE GOVERNOR'S
MANSION AND MANSION GROUNDS FROM THE FREEDOM OF
INFORMATION ACT OF 1967; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO EXEMPT CERTAIN RECORDS OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE
CONCERNING THE GOVERNOR'S MANSION AND
MANSION GROUNDS FROM THE FREEDOM OF
INFORMATION ACT OF 1967.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-8-108, concerning the security of the Governor, capitol building, etc., is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(c) Data, records, surveillance footage, security procedures, emergency plans, and other information compiled or possessed by the Department of Arkansas State Police concerning the Governor's mansion and mansion grounds are confidential and not subject to disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.
