## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO EXEMPT A LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN FROM REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR ADULT MALTREATMENT, LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY RESIDENT MALTREATMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO EXEMPT A LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN FROM REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR ADULT MALTREATMENT, LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY RESIDENT MALTREATMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1708(a)(1)(R), concerning the persons required to report adult or long-term care facility resident maltreatment, is amended to read as follows:

(R) An employee of the Department of Human Services with the exception of an employee working with an ombudsman program established by the Division of Aging and Adult Services of the Department of Human Services, in accordance with 42 U.S.C. § 3001 et seq., as it existed on January 1, 2017;
