# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1847

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR ARKANSAS AGRITOURISM SIGNS AT STATE WELCOME CENTERS AND TOURIST INFORMATION CENTERS THROUGH THE ARKANSAS WINE COUNTRY TRAILS PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROVIDE FOR ARKANSAS AGRITOURISM SIGNS AT STATE WELCOME CENTERS AND TOURIST INFORMATION CENTERS THROUGH THE ARKANSAS WINE COUNTRY TRAILS PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-67-224, concerning the Arkansas Wine Country Trail, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(c)(1) The Department of Parks and Tourism and the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department, in conjunction with the Arkansas Wine Producers Council, shall develop and install signs to promote Arkansas agritourism, incorporating Arkansas Wine Country Trail symbols, to be installed:

(A) On the main thoroughfare approaching welcome centers or tourist information centers within one (1) mile of the entrance to welcome centers or tourist information centers; or

(B) If installation on approach is not feasible, then on the main thoroughfare within one (1) mile past the entrance to welcome centers and tourist information centers or, if no feasible space exists in that mile, then as soon after that mile as possible.



(2) The signs shall be:

(A) A minimum of twelve feet by forty-eight feet (12' x 48'); and

(B) Constructed from:

(i) Steel; or

(ii) Treated lumber and recycled utility poles.
