AN ACT TO SET A SPECIAL HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSE
FEE FOR ACTIVE MILITARY MEMBERS HOME ON LEAVE IN
ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO SET A SPECIAL HUNTING AND FISHING
LICENSE FEE FOR ACTIVE MILITARY MEMBERS
HOME ON LEAVE IN ARKANSAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 42, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

15-42-130. Hunting and fishing licenses for active duty military on leave.

(a) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission may charge a maximum fee of one dollar fifty cents (\$1.50) for an annual resident hunting and fishing license for a resident of the state who is on active duty in the United States Armed Forces and permanently stationed outside of the state.

(b) An individual licensed under subsection (a) of this section shall carry a copy of the individual's leave papers while hunting or fishing.

(c) An individual licensed under subsection (a) of this section may hunt and fish under the annual resident hunting and fishing license for no more than thirty (30) days per year.
