# A Bill

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A MERCHANT TO REQUEST A PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARD BEFORE ACCEPTING AN ELECTRONIC BENEFITS TRANSFER CARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REQUIRE A MERCHANT TO REQUEST A PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARD BEFORE ACCEPTING AN ELECTRONIC BENEFITS TRANSFER CARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 76, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

20-76-114. Photographic identification for purchases with electronic benefits transfer card.

(a) A merchant shall require that a person show a card that displays a photograph of the person before accepting payment with an electronic benefits transfer card.

(b) The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules to implement this section.
