# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 2194

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A PERSON TO IDENTIFY HIMSELF OR HERSELF OR A GROUP TO IDENTIFY ITSELF ON MATERIAL THE PERSON OR GROUP MAILS CONCERNING AN ELECTION OR ADVOCATING FOR OR AGAINST A BALLOT MEASURE; TO ESTABLISH A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST A PERSON WHO FAILS TO IDENTIFY HIMSELF OR HERSELF OR A GROUP THAT FAILS TO IDENTIFY ITSELF ON MATERIAL THE PERSON OR GROUP MAILS CONCERNING AN ELECTION OR ADVOCATING FOR OR AGAINST A BALLOT MEASURE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

CONCERNING THE IDENTIFY OF A PERSON OR GROUP THAT MAILS MATERIAL CONCERNING AN ELECTION OR ADVOCATING FOR OR AGAINST A BALLOT MEASURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to require a person to identify himself or herself or a group to identify itself on material the person or group mails concerning an election or advocating for or against a ballot measure and to establish a civil action against a person that fails to identify himself or herself or a group that fails to identify itself on material the person or group mails concerning an election or advocating for or against a ballot measure.
