For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CREATE THE SLAVERY ABOLITION ACT OF 2017;
TO PROHIBIT SUBJECTING A PERSON TO FORCED LABOR
WITHOUT THE PROTECTIONS AFFORDED TO EMPLOYEES UNDER
THE MINIMUM WAGE ACT OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO CREATE THE SLAVERY ABOLITION ACT OF
2017; AND TO PROHIBIT FORCED LABOR
WITHOUT THE PROTECTIONS AFFORDED TO
EMPLOYEES UNDER THE STATE MINIMUM WAGE
LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to prohibit subjecting a person to forced labor without the protections afforded to employees under the Minimum Wage Act of the State of Arkansas.
