AN ACT CONCERNING BODY CAMERAS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS; TO ESTABLISH INCENTIVES FOR THE USE OF BODY CAMERAS AND BODY CAMERA DATA STORAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

CONCERNING BODY CAMERAS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS; AND TO ESTABLISH INCENTIVES FOR THE USE OF BODY CAMERAS AND BODY CAMERA DATA STORAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

12-12-110. Body cameras.

(a) As used in this section, "body-worn camera" means an electronic device worn on a person's body that records both audio and video. (b)(1) A state or local law enforcement agency shall implement the use of body-worn cameras under guidelines to be established by the Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training.

(2) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
