CONGRATULATING THE PARIS HIGH SCHOOL VOLLEYBALL TEAM
FOR AN OUTSTANDING RECORD.

WHEREAS, the Paris High School volleyball team has made five (5) consecutive trips to the state volleyball finals in 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015, winning back-to-back state titles in 2015 and 2016, and marking the only other state sports titles for Paris High School since the 1997 girls' tennis team and the 1925 girls' basketball team; and

WHEREAS, in the last seven (7) years, the Paris High School volleyball team has one hundred fifty-six (156) wins and fifty-eight (58) losses, including wins over 4A, 5A, 6A, and 7A opponents; and

WHEREAS, during that seven-year period, the volleyball team has brought home five (5) district tournament titles and three (3) conference titles and had one (1) quarterfinal appearance and one (1) semifinal appearance, with the semifinal appearance as the first district win for the volleyball team in twenty-three (23) years; and

WHEREAS, the team has produced an All-American player and multiple All-State players; and



WHEREAS, the team has been ably led and inspired by excellent Head Coach Wes Davis, who was also selected for and coached the All-Star volleyball game in the summer of 2016; and

WHEREAS, the motto for the team is "CANI", which means "Constant And Never-ending Improvement", a motto that has encouraged the team, along with the support of their families, friends, and the community, through all their challenges and successes and is a tribute to their talent, hard work, and leadership,

NOW THEREFORE,
