WHEREAS, on January 20, 2012, Correctional Corporal Barbara Ester died as a result of injuries incurred while on duty at the East Arkansas Regional Unit in Brickeys, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, in attempting to confiscate contraband from an inmate, Cpl. Ester sustained mortal stab wounds to the chest; and

WHEREAS, in spite of her injuries, Cpl. Ester maintained control of the situation and was able to alert other officers; and

WHEREAS, her actions reflect the outstanding character of correctional officers; and

WHEREAS, Cpl. Ester was a twelve-year veteran of the Arkansas Department of Correction at the end of her service to the State of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, Cpl. Ester was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and loyal and respected member of the community of Marianna, Arkansas; and



WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Correction has honored Cpl. Ester's memory by naming the department's first reentry facility in her honor,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
