AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS;
TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT
REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS OF THE DIRECTOR AND
OF VETERANS' CLAIMS SPECIALISTS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
AFFAIRS; AND TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING
CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS AND
QUALIFICATIONS OF THE DIRECTOR AND OF
VETERANS' CLAIMS SPECIALISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-81-103(c), concerning the qualifications required for the director and employees of the Department of Veterans Affairs, is amended to read as follows:

(c) The director ~~shall maintain his or her office in space provided by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs Regional Benefit Office Building in Little Rock, Arkansas, and~~ may establish, maintain, and operate such other district offices within the State of Arkansas as may be necessary.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-81-103(e)(1), concerning the qualifications required for the director and employees of the Department of Veterans Affairs, is amended to read as follows:

(e)(1) ~~All~~ A veterans' claims specialists shall have served in the



United States Armed Forces ~~during armed conflict, as set forth by Congress,~~
and shall have been honorably discharged therefrom. ~~They shall have been~~
~~citizens of the State of Arkansas for a period of three (3) years prior to~~
~~appointment.~~
