AN ACT CONFERRING STATEWIDE JURISDICTION TO A
CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER EMPLOYED BY THE
STATE PARKS DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND
TOURISM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONFERRING STATEWIDE JURISDICTION TO A
CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
EMPLOYED BY THE STATE PARKS DIVISION OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 11, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

15-11-212. Enforcement of state law – Statewide jurisdiction.

A person designated as and employed as a law enforcement officer by the Department of Parks and Tourism shall:

- (1) Be a certified law enforcement officer under § 12-9-101 et seq.; and
- (2) Have statewide law enforcement jurisdiction and authority.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 22-4-103(9), concerning the power of the State Parks, Recreation, and Travel Commission, is amended to read as follows:

- (9) To confer on employees of the department the full authority



of peace officers for all land under its jurisdiction and to confer on a certified law enforcement officer employed by the commission the authority to enforce the laws of the state, as permitted by law, anywhere within the state.
