AN ACT TO ALLOW A WET COUNTY TO AUTHORIZE BY
ORDINANCE THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ON-
PREMISES CONSUMPTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO ALLOW A WET COUNTY TO AUTHORIZE BY
ORDINANCE THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-9-203(d), concerning the purpose and effect of referendum election regarding the sale of alcoholic beverages, is amended to read as follows:

(d)(1) A property owner's association with a population of five thousand (5,000) or more or a county, city, or town may authorize by ordinance the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption under this subchapter if the property owner's association or ~~a~~ the county, city, or town is located in or is a county that authorized the manufacture and sale of *intoxicating liquor* ~~after November 1, 2012~~.

(2) The authority of a county quorum court under subdivision (d)(1) of this section applies only to unincorporated areas of the county.
