For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE SCHOOL TRANSPARENCY; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE SCHOOL TRANSPARENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 15, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-15-104. School transparency.

A school that receives state funds shall:

(1) Comply with the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.; and

(2) Disclose on its website:

(A) The details of the manner in which the school conducts its admissions lottery, if applicable;

(B)(i) If the school has an admissions process, a compilation of the demographics of:

(a) All applicants to the school; and

(b) The applicants selected for admission to the school.

(ii) A school shall not disclose any personally identifiable information of a student under subdivision (a)(2)(B)(i) of this section;

(C) The school's full budget; and

(D) The school's sources of any private funding, if



applicable.
