For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE FILING OF BILLS BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; TO RELIEVE PRESSURE ON LEGISLATIVE STAFF; TO ALLOW LEGISLATIVE STAFF TIME AND OPPORTUNITY TO FULFILL REQUESTS FOR LEGISLATION BEFORE THE FILING DEADLINE; TO PROHIBIT THE MEETING OF LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES THE DAY OF THE BILL FILING DEADLINE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE FILING OF BILLS BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; TO RELIEVE PRESSURE ON LEGISLATIVE STAFF; AND TO PROHIBIT THE MEETING OF COMMITTEES AT BILL FILING DEADLINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act concerns the filing of bills by the General Assembly, the relieving of pressure on legislative staff, the allowance of time and opportunity for legislative staff to fulfill requests for legislation before the filing deadline, and the prohibition of the meeting of legislative committees the day of the bill filing deadline.
