AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING IN-STATE TUITION
FOR VETERANS, MILITARY PERSONNEL, AND DEPENDENTS; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING IN-STATE
TUITION FOR VETERANS, MILITARY PERSONNEL,
AND DEPENDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-60-205 is amended to read as follows:

6-60-205. In-state tuition for veterans and military personnel and dependents.

Regardless of residence, a state-supported institution of higher education, trade school, or vocational school shall classify a student as in-state, in-county, in-district, local, or resident for the purpose of tuition and fees applicable for all programs of study, including distance learning programs, if the student is a:

- (1) Veteran who ~~was discharged or released~~ received an honorable discharge from a period of not less than ninety (90) days of active duty in the ~~military, naval, or air service~~ United States Armed Forces within three (3) years before the date of enrollment in a program of study;
- (2) Dependent of a veteran under subdivision (1) of this section;
- (3) Member of the ~~armed forces~~ United States Armed Forces; ~~or~~
- (4) Spouse of a member of the ~~armed forces~~ United States Armed



Forces; or

(5) Reserve Officers' Training Corps cadet who has an executed United States Armed Forces service contract.
