## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO AMEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY; TO AMEND THE RULES CONCERNING THE FILING OF BILLS BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; TO AMEND THE RULES IN ORDER TO RELIEVE PRESSURE ON LEGISLATIVE STAFF; TO AMEND THE RULES TO ALLOW LEGISLATIVE STAFF TIME AND OPPORTUNITY TO FULFILL REQUESTS FOR LEGISLATION BEFORE THE FILING DEADLINE; AND TO AMEND THE RULES TO PROHIBIT THE MEETING OF LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES THE DAY OF THE BILL FILING DEADLINE.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this resolution is to amend the joint rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Ninety-First General Assembly regarding the filing of bills by the General Assembly, relieving pressure on legislative staff, allowing legislative staff time and opportunity to fulfill requests for legislation before the filing deadline, and prohibiting the meeting of legislative committees the day of the bill filing deadline.
