WHEREAS, the 91st General Assembly has referred two (2) proposed constitutional amendments to the electors of the state for approval or rejection; and

WHEREAS, Section 19(C) of the Joint Rules of the 91st General Assembly provides that a third (3rd) proposed constitutional amendment shall not be considered or voted upon by the General Assembly until identical resolutions authorizing the consideration of the proposed constitutional amendment have been approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to each house,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT Representative Gillam is authorized to pursue the consideration of HJR 1003 as a third (3rd) proposed constitutional amendment for referral to



the electors of the state for approval or rejection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Senator Williams is authorized to pursue the consideration of HJR 1003 if the joint resolution comes before the Senate for consideration.
