BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 91ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

WHEREAS, Leadership Arkansas is a program introduced in 2005 by the Arkansas State Chamber of Commerce as an opportunity for individuals to gain a comprehensive view of the economic and political challenges that face the state and to experience the interactions between governmental bodies, industries, and the people they serve; and

WHEREAS, Leadership Arkansas provides an opportunity during a one-day class session for each member of the yearly class to assume the role of a legislator and work with sitting elected legislative leaders and various special interest groups to move sample bills through the legislative process from introduction in the committee room to final passage or defeat on the chamber floor; and



WHEREAS, Leadership Arkansas includes participation by more than fifty (50) individuals representing businesses, organizations, municipalities, and state agencies across Arkansas,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House of Representatives of the Ninety-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas recognizes Leadership Arkansas for its commitment to the legislative process and grants Leadership Arkansas access to and use of the chamber of the House of Representatives for a class session once a year, so long as the chamber of the House of Representatives is not in official use by the members of the House of Representatives.
