## SENATE RESOLUTION

TO AUTHORIZE THE INTRODUCTION OF A NONAPPROPRIATION  
BILL CONCERNING THE POSSESSION AND CARRYING OF A  
CONCEALED HANDGUN IN ON-CAMPUS COLLEGIATE OR  
UNIVERSITY HOUSING.

### Subtitle

TO AUTHORIZE THE INTRODUCTION OF A  
NONAPPROPRIATION BILL CONCERNING THE  
POSSESSION AND CARRYING OF A CONCEALED  
HANDGUN IN ON-CAMPUS COLLEGIATE OR  
UNIVERSITY HOUSING.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT Senator Bond is authorized to introduce a bill which, as introduced,  
will read substantially as follows:

"For An Act To Be Entitled  
AN ACT CONCERNING THE POSSESSION AND CARRYING OF A CONCEALED HANDGUN IN ON-  
CAMPUS COLLEGIATE OR UNIVERSITY HOUSING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle  
CONCERNING THE POSSESSION AND CARRYING OF A CONCEALED HANDGUN IN ON-CAMPUS  
COLLEGIATE OR UNIVERSITY HOUSING.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The lead-in language to Arkansas Code § 5-73-306, concerning the places where possession of a concealed handgun is prohibited, is amended to read as follows:

Except as permitted under § 5-73-322(~~g~~), a license to carry a concealed handgun issued under this subchapter does not authorize a person to carry a concealed handgun into:

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-322(d), concerning storage of a concealed handgun in a university- or college-operated dormitory or residence hall, is amended to read as follows:

(d)(1) The ~~storage~~ carrying or possession of a handgun in a nonpublic student room in a university ~~university-~~ or college-operated student dormitory or residence hall is prohibited under this section and § 5-73-119(c).

(2)(A) As used in subdivision (d)(1) of this section, "nonpublic student room" means a room in which a student sleeps, keeps his or her personal effects, and either occupies privately or with one (1) or more roommates.

(B) "Nonpublic student room" includes a private common area where two (2) or more nonpublic student rooms directly connect to and share a private living space shared by all the connected nonpublic student rooms.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-73-322(h)(2), concerning the exempted places for a concealed carry licensee with a concealed carry endorsement, is amended to read as follows:

(2) Carrying a concealed handgun in a prohibited place listed under § 5-73-306(7)-(12), (14), (15), and (17), unless otherwise prohibited under this section, § 5-73-306(19), or § 5-73-306(20)."
