BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That Senator Clark is authorized to introduce a bill which as introduced will
read substantially as follows:

"For An Act To Be Entitled

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-18-1906(b)(1)(B), concerning the manner



in which siblings are counted as transfer students in the Public School Choice Act of 2015, is repealed.

~~(B) For the purpose of determining the percentage of school choice transfers under this subsection, siblings who are counted in the numerator as transfer students shall count as one (1) student."~~
