AN ACT TO REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL TO PROVIDE *THAT BLEEDING CONTROL TRAINING BE TAUGHT TO STUDENTS* IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-12); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL TO PROVIDE THAT BLEEDING CONTROL TRAINING BE TAUGHT TO STUDENTS IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-12).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-10-133. Bleeding control training.

(a) Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, each public school shall provide bleeding control training as a component of a health course to be taught to students in grades nine through twelve (9-12).

(b) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the Department of Health, shall develop the bleeding control training required under this section using instructional materials developed or endorsed by the:

- (1) American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma;
- (2) National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians; or
- (3) Department of Health.

(c) The Department of Education may promulgate rules to enforce this



section.
