## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE FORFEITURE OF  
RETIREMENT BENEFITS BY A JUDGE OR JUSTICE WHO IS  
SEVENTY (70) YEARS OF AGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE  
FORFEITURE OF RETIREMENT BENEFITS BY A  
JUDGE OR JUSTICE WHO IS SEVENTY (70)  
YEARS OF AGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-8-215(c)(1), concerning the forfeiture of retirement benefits by judges or justices who become seventy (70) years of age during a term of office to which they are elected, is amended to read as follows:

(c)(1) ~~Any A judge or justice who becomes seventy (70) years of age during a term of office to which he or she has been elected~~ is not seventy (70) years of age on the date on which he or she is elected to a term of office may complete the term without forfeiting his or her rights to retirement benefits under this section.
