AN ACT TO AMEND THE EXEMPTION TO LICENSURE BY THE  
VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD FOR CHIROPRACTORS  
PERFORMING CHIROPRACTIC UPON ANIMALS; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE EXEMPTION TO LICENSURE BY  
THE VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD  
FOR CHIROPRACTORS PERFORMING CHIROPRACTIC  
UPON ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-101-307(b)(10), concerning the  
exemptions to licensure by the Veterinary Medical Examining Board, is amended  
to read as follows:

(10) ~~Any~~ A chiropractor licensed in this state and certified by  
the American Veterinary Chiropractic Association from performing chiropractic  
upon animals ~~so long as the chiropractic is performed under the immediate  
supervision of an Arkansas licensed veterinarian; or~~
